- ✓ Connect to Neighborhood Incident Command Post (ICP) Network
- ✓ GO Turn on FRS radio to Channel 19-36
- ✓ Check in to your net: "[call sign] checking in"

- 1. Immediate medical incidents
- Burning fire threatening lives or neighboring prop.
- . Hazards that are a threat to safety
- 4. Structural Damage <u>with</u> trapped victims REPORT CRITICAL EVENTS IMMEDIATELY
